ARRIVE ZURICH

DAY ONE

ZURICH TO LUCERNE

DAY FOUR

DAY FIVE

DAY SIX

LUCERNE TO INTERLAKEN

DAY EIGHT

The journey continues aboard the Lucerne-Interlaken Express, one of Switzerland's most scenic rail routes. Panoramic windows frame a snowy wonderland of frozen lakes, lush valleys, and cascading waterfalls en route to Interlaken. Winter wraps the entire route in a pristine blanket of white.

INTERLAKEN

DAY NINE

Switzerland's adventure capital awaits, with the option to journey to Jungfraujoch - the "Top of Europe". Located within a UNESCO World Heritage site, travelers can view the longest glacier in the alps. Travelers can also ride the Harder Kulm Funicular or explore the open-air Ballenberg Museum. Winter opens up world-class skiing, snowboarding, and tobogganing across the region.

INTERLAKEN

DAY TEN

Spend the day discovering Interlaken on foot, perhaps beginning with a stroll along the Hoheweg promenade, lined with shops, restaurants and lovely views of the Jungfrau range. Nearby gardens and parks add to the town's charm. Interlaken is a paradise for outdoor lovers, with hiking trails easily accessible both within town and throughout the surrounding region.

INTERLAKEN TO MONTREUX

DAY TWELVE

Travelers board the iconic GoldenPass Express for a breathtaking ride through the Alps to Montreux. This journey is extraordinary in every season with winter's snow-laden pine forests, frozen meadows, and charming chalet villages unfolding through the panoramic windows in spectacular fashion.

MONTREUX

DAY THIRTEEN

Spend the day venturing beyond the lakeside into the dramatic alpine terrain surrounding Montreux. Ascend to Glacier 3000 for breathtaking panoramic views atop a tongue of ancient ice - take the Peak Walk suspension bridge and, in winter, the ski slopes. Alternatively, ride the rack railway up to Rochers-de-Naye for sweeping vistas over Lake Geneva and the arc of the Alps, where a colony of marmots and Alpine flora await. Both excursions offer a profound sense of elevation and wilderness just moments from the lakeside town below.

MONTREUX

DAY FOURTEEN

Today belongs entirely to travelers, with the freedom to explore the Montreux Riviera at leisure. History lovers can wander through the towers and dungeons of medieval Chillon Castle, perched dramatically on a rocky islet at the water's edge. Those drawn to the town itself can stroll the promenade, browse the boutiques, or linger over lunch at a cafe overlooking the lake. The season adds its own character with one of Switzerland's most magical Christmas markets in winter.
